

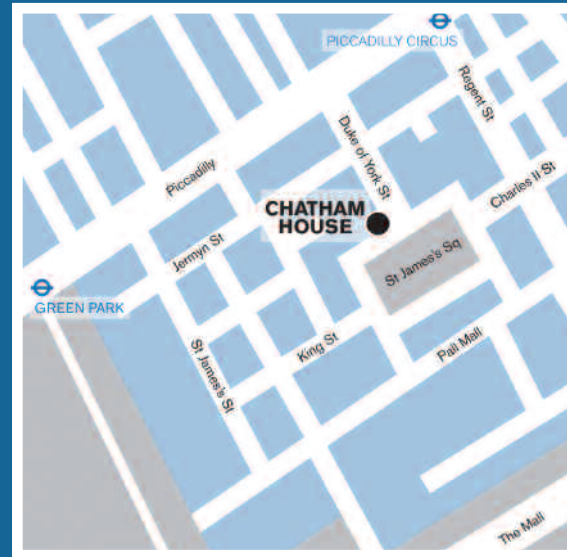
Once the dwelling of three prime ministers - William Pitt (Earl of Chatham), the Earl of Derby and William Ewart Gladstone - today Chatham House still welcomes the world's top political and business leaders.

This attractive eighteenth-century listed building, constructed by the same partnership as 10 Downing Street, is home to the Royal Institute of International Affairs, a leading global international relations think tank. It overlooks one of London's largest and greenest squares, and is just a few minutes' walk from Piccadilly and Green Park underground stations.

### Neill Malcolm Room

Overlooking St James's Square, the ground-floor Neill Malcolm Room was once William Pitt's ballroom. It can be linked to other equally elegant rooms and is ideal for receptions, cocktail parties, dinners and buffet luncheons.

### Astor Room

### Joseph Gaggero Hall

The JGH is purpose-built for conferences, meetings and seminars. A raised platform 2m x 8m (approx) ensures excellent visibility for speakers and creates an intimate atmosphere for discussion. Sound-proof partitions enable the hall to be converted into two smaller units, each with its own platform and entrance.
